Deaf and Dumb- <i>Inability to speak and unable to hear</i>	Dumbness, mental illness, epilepsy, suicidal, hearing (natural and spiritual), ear problems	Loose the Gift of Light, Life and Love	Mark 9:17; Mark 9:22; Mark 9:18, 26; Matthew 17:15; Matthew 12:22

Seducing Spirit- <i>to cause to wander, lead stray, deceiving, seducing</i>	Hypocritical lies, scared conscience, deceived, wander from truth, attractions, fascination by false prophets, false signs and wonders, fascination to evil things, ways and people, enticed, Religions. Spirit of Jezebel- Literally translated means “without cohabitation”. This spirit is without gender	Desire to control and dominate others, sexual perversity, fiercely independent and intensely ambitious, unbridled witchcraft and hatred for male authority and the prophets of God.
